Population in Europe 2004 First results

Joint Council of Europe/Eurostat demographic data collection

▶ This publication provides the **first results** on main demographic trends in Europe 2004. The results are derived from the demographic data collection conducted jointly by the Council of Europe and Eurostat. They provide data on the Member States of the European Union as well as on the other countries that are Members of the Council of Europe. ▶ Some figures presented in this publication are **provisional** or estimates. Additional and more definitive information will be published in the forthcoming annual reports of the Council of Europe ("Recent demographic developments in Europe 2005") and Eurostat ("Population statistics 2006").

Main demographic trends for 2004

▶ The **population** of the **European Union** is estimated to have increased by 2.3 million or 0.5% in 2004, slightly more than in 2003 (2.1 million). It was the largest increase in more than 30 years. The relative increase was highest in Cyprus (2004: 2.5%) and Ireland (2.0%). In several central and eastern European countries the population decreased in 2004. ▶ It is remarkable that in most of the countries the **natural increase** of the population was higher in 2004 than 2003. This is mainly due to unusually fluctuating mortality rates: the hot summer of 2003 possibly led to more deaths in that year and, as a consequence, fewer deaths in 2004. This has a positive impact on the calculation of the (net) natural increase of the population from 2003 to 2004. ▶ Although the natural increase in the EU more than doubled compared to 2003, 80% of the total increase was due to net inward **migration** (1.9 million). Spain had the highest absolute net migration in the EU (610 100) followed by Italy (558 200). However, for both countries the figures are inflated by regularisation programmes, thus including persons who may have arrived before 2004. ► The total fertility rate for the EU has again grown slightly from 1.48 in 2003 to 1.50 in 2004 (see table 3). The comparable rate for the US stood at 2.07. Generally, fertility was below the average in the Member States in central and eastern Europe (Slovenia: 1.22; Poland, Czech Republic: 1.23 each; Latvia: 1.24). Within the EU it was highest in Ireland (1.99), France (1.90) and Finland (1.80). In no country of the EU the total fertility rate came close to the replacement level of about 2.1 children per woman. ▶ The trend of more children being born outside marriage continues: about one in three live births in the EU are outside marriage. In 2004, the number of marriages in the EU is virtually the same as in 2003 (2.2 million). The upward trend in the divorces continues, to stand at a level of nearly 1 million in 2004 (see table 5).

▶ Most central and eastern European countries faced a population decrease, but the largest occurred in **Member States of the Council of Europe outside the EU**: the Ukraine experienced a loss in the **population** of over 0.3 million (- 0.7%), the Russian Federation of 0.7 million (- 0.5%). ▶ Only a couple of Member States of the Council of Europe had a **total fertility rate** close to the replacement level (Azerbaijan: 2.05; Iceland: 2.03). The only country exceeding the replacement level was Turkey (2.2). The population in Turkey increased by 0.9 million (1.3 %). ▶ While the **infant mortality** rate in the EU declines to a level of 4.5 per 1 000 live births (see table 4), infant mortality is still high in some countries outside the EU (Turkey: 21.5; Romania: 16.8; "The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia": 13.2; Moldova: 12.1; Bulgaria: 11.6; Armenia, Russian Federation: 11.5 each).

Figure 1: World population, 2005




Figure 2: Share of the world's population increase, 2004





Figure 3: Components of population change, 2004 (per 1 000 population)



GLOSSARY

Natural increase: the difference between the number of live births and the number of deaths.

Net migration: the difference between the number of immigrants and the number of emigrants. Since most countries either do not have accurate figures on immigration and emigration or have no figures at all, net migration is estimated, in this publication, on the basis of the difference between population change and natural increase between the two dates concerned. The statistics on net migration are therefore affected by all the statistical inaccuracies in the two components of this equation, especially population change (that includes notably corrections due to population censuses, register counts, etc. which cannot be classified as births, deaths or migrations). Note that changes to national systems and methodologies for population statistics may result in unusually high or low numbers in one or more years.

Crude rate: The crude rate is estimated as the ratio of the number of events to the mean population in a given year. For better presentation, it is often multiplied by 1000.

Total fertility rate: the average number of children that would be born alive to a woman during her lifetime if current age specific fertility rates were to continue.

Infant mortality rate: the ratio of deaths of children under one year of age to the live births in a given year. For better presentation, it is often multiplied by 1000.

Life expectancy at birth: the average number of years a person would live if current age specific mortality rates were to continue.

Council of Europe Member States: all the European Union countries, Albania (AL), Andorra (AD), Armenia (AM), Azerbaijan (AZ), Bosnia and Herzegovina (BA), Bulgaria (BG), Croatia (HR), Georgia (GE), Iceland (IS), Liechtenstein (LI), Moldova (MD), Norway (NO), Romania (RO), Russian Federation (RU), San Marino (SM), Serbia and Montenegro (CS), Switzerland (CH), "The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia" (MK), Turkey (TR), Ukraine (UA).

Council of Europe non-Member States: Belarus (BY).

More developed countries: all countries in Europe (including European members of the CIS-Commonwealth of Independent States), Australia, Canada, Japan, New Zealand, Turkey, the United States of America.

Less developed countries: all countries excluding more developed countries.
