EUR-Lex allows you to easily navigate between and search for the authentic version of the *Official Journal of the European Union*, consolidated texts and summaries of EU legislation, treaties, legal acts, preparatory documents, case-law, international agreements, and national case-law related to EU law. This means more than 1 million legal documents that help you understand EU law and follow the cycle of EU lawmaking.

You can also create your own account to customise your experience and enjoy extra features.

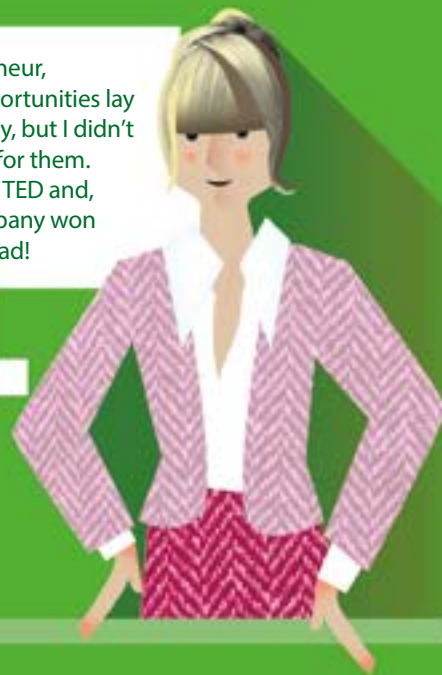

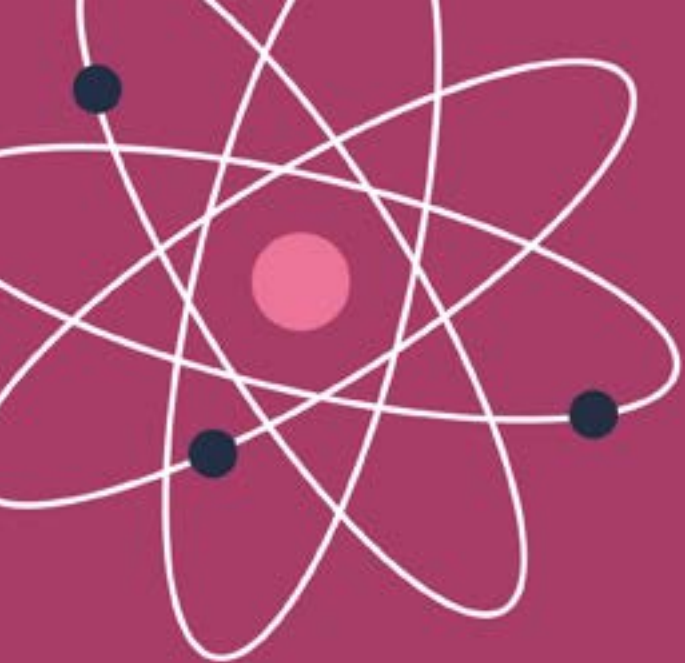


Business opportunities

Then we have just the thing for you: **Tenders Electronic Daily** (TED), a platform that provides you with free access to public procurement notices from the EU and beyond. It is updated five times a week, with an average of approximately 2 600 notices a day in 24 languages. You can browse, search and sort procurement notices by country, region, business sector, etc. You can also set up email alerts and RSS feeds to be notified when new opportunities matching your criteria are published.

All of these titles are available to you for free in electronic format, with some of them orderable in paper format (charges may apply). Since many of the titles in the EU Publications website exist in several language versions, you can find content in more than 70 different languages.
