## PUBLIC EXPENDITURE ON EDUCATION AND TRAINING IN THE COMMUNITY IN 1981

Education and training financed by central and local governments in the Community of Nine and carried out in both public and private institutions amounted to 120.6 billion ECU in 1981. This represented 11.5% of total public expenditure and 5.4% of gross domestic product, with variations about these figures in individual Member States.

Compared with the previous year, public expenditure on education and training rose by 11.9% at current prices and by 1.2% at constant prices, i.e. in real terms. Particularly high increases in real terms were made in Italy (9.6%), Ireland (9.2%) and Luxemburg (7.3%), whilst in the Netherlands and Belgium expenditure in real terms actually fell slightly.

This expenditure corresponded to 461 ECU per inhabitant. However, comparisons between countries are better made in Purchasing Power Standards (PPS), which reflect approximately the same purchasing power in each country (see explanatory notes, page 7). Figures per inhabitant ranged from 412 PPS in Ireland to 716 PPS in Denmark, with a Community average of 496 PPS.

Approximately 93% of the expenditure was absorbed by the school system (including technical colleges, universities, etc.) whilst the remaining 7% was spent outside the school system on vocational training and adult education generally of a part-time or short duration nature. Altogether vocational training, both within and outside the school system, accounted for over 15% of total expenditure (see explanatory notes concerning national interpretation of vocational training).

Analysis is given in the tables of this bulletin mainly in the form of percentages of total expenditure so that the reader can calculate figures for himself either in ECU, in PPS or in national currencies.

It has not yet been found possible to include figures for Greece.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTES

Total public expenditure is the total expenditure on goods and services, salaries, transfers, etc. by general government, comprising central government, local government and social security funds (ESA code S60).

Public expenditure on education and training is the expenditure of central government and local government on education and training, in principle net of fees or other contributions paid by students or their parents. It comprises the following items:

- Teaching and administration

- a) current expenditure includes salaries and social security contributions of teachers and other persons, the purchase of goods and services, rents, etc.
- b) capital expenditure comprises the purchase of land, buildings and durable equipment.

- Transfers to households: scholarships, loans and other forms of direct assistance.

- Supplementary expenditure of a social nature: school transport, medical services, meals and accommodation, etc.

The European Currency Unit (ECU) and the Purchasing Power Standard (PPS) are means by which national currencies may be converted to a common unit. The ECU is a 'basket' of currencies and conversions depend on monetary exchange rates. Because the purchasing value on one national currency relative to another is not necessarily reflected by the exchange rate, the concept of a Purchasing Power Standard has been introduced. When national currencies are converted to PPS the figures indicate approximately corresponding purchasing powers. The parities used in this bulletin are based on gross domestic product; for a more complete description see "Comparison in real values of the aggregates of ESA-1980"; EUROSTAT, 1983.

The School System includes technical colleges, universities, etc. and covers children from whatever age they start school up to the minimum legal leaving age and beyond it for those who remain at school then may or may not continue in higher education. Attendance is for the most part full-time and continuous, but there are exceptions.

The school system comprises:

- Pre-school level: education prior to the beginning of compulsory schooling.
- First level: elementary education, generally lasting about five years.
- Second level, first stage: approximately the next three years and is compulsory.

- Second level, second stage: lasts for about three years in the majority of cases and leads up to the standard required for entry into higher education. Depending on the country, it may begin when compulsory schooling ends or the initial part may still be compulsory.
- Third level: universities and all other forms of higher education.
- Special education: for physically, sensorially or handicapped children.

For the correspondence between these levels and national types of institution see "Education and Training 1970/71 - 1977/78": EUROSTAT 1980.

Vocational training has no internationally accepted definition to distinguish it from general education. The distinction in this bulletin is therefore subject to national interpretation. The following types, however, are generally recognised:

- Initial vocational training: for those who have not yet started a regular job, including apprentices.
- Adult vocational training: for those who are in or have had a regular job, whether or not they received initial vocational training.
